

IHB Limited signs Interconnection Agreement with APSEZL to Strengthen Infrastructure Connectivity



IHB Limited and Adani Ports and Special Economic Zone Limited (APSEZL) signed an Interconnection Agreement on June 25, 2026, for the hook-up of the Mundra–Kandla Pipeline (MKPL) of APSEZL with the Kandla–Gorakhpur LPG Pipeline (KGPL) at Mithi Rohar, Kandla. With commissioning of this connectivity, KGPL will start to operate with 2 ports Kandla & Mundra as source LPG input to KGPL.

The interconnection is expected to facilitate seamless integration between the two pipeline networks, enabling efficient transfer of product, enhancing operational flexibility, and optimising the utilisation of existing pipeline infrastructure. The project represents a significant step towards strengthening energy logistics and supporting the development of an integrated and reliable pipeline transportation network.

The signing of the Interconnection Agreement reflects the shared commitment of IHB and APSEZL to foster collaboration for the development of critical energy infrastructure. By establishing a clear operational and commercial framework, the Agreement is expected to facilitate efficient execution, long-term operation, and effective maintenance of the interconnection facilities.
